



Transfer Credit Evaluation

Students transferring to Cleveland State receive a transfer credit evaluation (TCE) approximately four to six weeks after being formally admitted and after all final transcripts have been received.

Once your TCE has been processed, you will be able to view the results of the evaluation by doing the following:

1. Log into CampusNet.



2. Select the "Student" tab (only available to admitted students). The tabs will look like this:



3. Select the "Transcript" link as shown below. The Cleveland State equivalents for your completed TCE will now appear in your Unofficial Transcript.



4. Questions regarding your TCE? Use the **Ask@Question** link located on the transcript page.

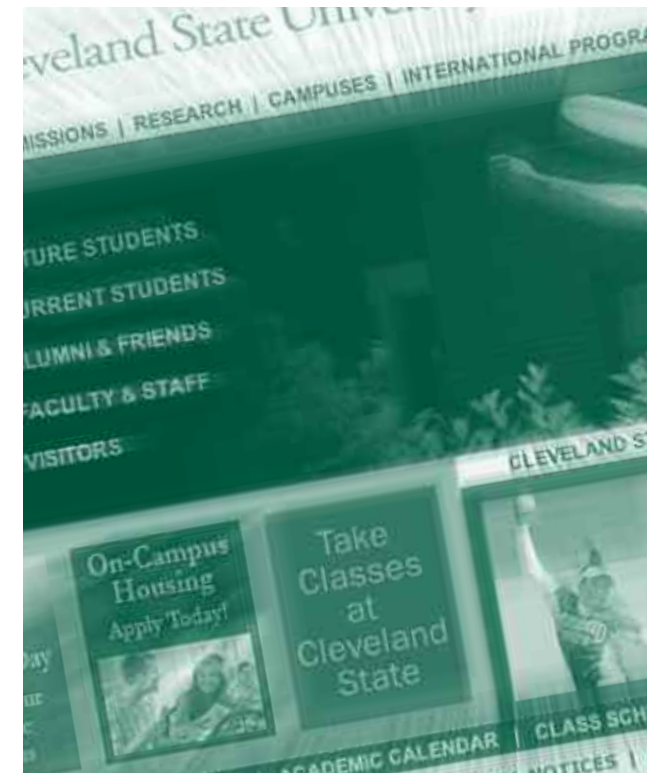

As an applicant, you have access to track the status of your application and to view your admission decision once it is available. If you have problems using the system, select the Help icon in the upper right hand corner of the screen when you are logged on to CampusNet.

1. Log on to CampusNet using your seven digit Cleveland State University ID number and your CampusPass password.
2. If you did not receive or have forgotten your ID and/or password, call (216) 687-5050 for assistance.
3. Once you are successfully logged in, you will be required to change your password. Carefully follow the password requirements that are listed on the screen.
4. Select the "Applicant" tab to see the current status of your application. The tabs will look like this:



5. Once you have selected "Applicant," you have the option of seeing a Summary of your application and its status, the status of your application Materials (transcripts, test scores and application fee) and your preliminary Placement for Math and English (only available for students with ACT/SAT test scores.)



6. Once all of your application materials have been received, please allow one to two weeks for the processing. After one to two weeks, an admission decision on your application will appear on the Summary page.
