Cleveland State's MBA at Extended Campuses and Corporate Sites offers the same great curriculum as our traditional MBA at locations all around Greater Cleveland, including our Extended Campus locations in Westlake and Solon, corporate sites in North Olmsted and Mayfield Heights and the downtown campus.



QUALITY

All Nance business and accountancy programs are accredited by the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB), the hallmark of excellence in management education. Only 15 percent of business schools in the world hold AACSB accreditation.

Students who choose the Extended Campus MBA option receive the same excellent education that traditional MBA students receive. The comprehensive curriculum gives students tools they can put to work right away. Cleveland State's partnerships keep the curriculum current and practitioner-focused, and allow faculty to address the most timely and relevant management issues. The unusual mix of domestic and international students employed in a wide variety of industries also enhances learning and provides a strong network for success.

LEARNING

The Nance College of Business Administration has designed a comprehensive curriculum for business learning. Firmly grounded in sound business theory and taught by world-class professors, the Nance program builds upon this theory in its exploration of practical business problems. Graduates are prepared for a future of long-term, accelerated career growth.

Students will also prepare to excel in the global marketplace amid a mix of students from a range of professional backgrounds, ages and nations.

THE PROGRAM

The Extended Campus MBA is set up in 10-week terms that allow students to complete the program in as few as 15 months, depending on their undergraduate course work. Students can choose from convenient locations at West Center Extended Campus in Westlake, East Center Extended Campus in Solon, and two Corporate Sites in Mayfield Heights and North Olmsted.

The Nance program consists of three levels of courses. Level One courses focus on developing quantitative and verbal skills. Level Two courses build a foundation for business by covering all major business disciplines: accounting, economics, finance, international business, management, marketing and operations. The program culminates with Level Three courses that focus on the integration and synthesis of the knowledge acquired in the program.

The Nance MBA is built around a set of advanced, interdisciplinary core courses that enable students to understand connections across an entire business. In addition, the Extended Campus MBA program includes three pre-determined electives.



FACULTY

The faculty at Nance is comprised of experts in various disciplines and leaders in research. All MBA faculty have the highest degree in their field and remain engaged in the business community through consulting, membership in professional organizations and community leadership. The professors bring a wealth of business experience to the classroom. Many corporations rely on Nance faculty for problem solving and innovative ideas. Cleveland State's potent combination of academic research, teaching skills and knowledge of current business issues deliver a powerful learning experience.

OPTIONS
