Finance Major Requirements: Students must take a minimum of 24 semester hours of Finance courses beyond FIN 351. This consists of **two** Finance core courses (FIN 353 and FIN 360) and a minimum of 16 credit hours in Finance electives (selected from list above). All Finance electives must be at the 300-level or higher.

Effective Spring 2008, a minimum grade of "C" or higher is required in **all** Finance courses. Before declaring a Finance major, all Lower Division Requirements must be completed. Finance core courses in which a grade below "C" was earned **must** be repeated. Finance elective courses with a grade below "C" must either be repeated or substituted by completing a different elective. Areas of specialization within the major include Investment Management, Management of Financial Institutions, Real Estate, and Financial Management.
