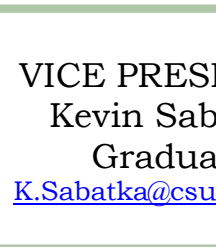
OFFICER OPENINGS

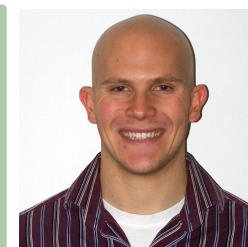
