In addition to the items listed above, students must earn:

- A minimum of 42 total credit hours of Junior/Senior (CSU 300/400) level courses (referred to as the "upper division requirement")
 - CSU PSY courses at the 300/400 level will be applied to this requirement
 - LCCC PSYH 257, 261, 263, 271 and 272 will be applied to this requirement
 - Upper division coursework transferred from another university will apply to this requirement
 - Upper division electives can be taken online or at a CSU campus
- A minimum of 128 total credit hours (including all eligible transfer credits from LCCC and all credit earned at CSU)
- A total of 30 credit hours of study at Cleveland State, 24 credit hours of which must be upper division coursework at Cleveland State (can include courses taken online through CSU; referred to as the "residency requirement")

Partnership Hints

- When applying to CSU you must complete the *Application Supplement for Partnership Admission* form
- If you plan to use leftover financial aid to pay for Lorain tuition, you must complete a *Consortium Agreement*
- Have LCCC transcripts sent to CSU after each semester you attend classes at LCCC
- Complete a CSU graduation application with your CSU advisor the semester before you plan to graduate
- A CSU advisor will be available for appointments in the University Center at LCCC twice per month
