## Middle Childhood Education

The Middle School Mathematics test (0069) is designed to certify examinees as teachers of middle school mathematics.

The test is comprised of 40 multiple-choice and 3 short constructed response questions to assess the examinee's knowledge of different areas of mathematics.

The sessions are intended to assist students in their preparation for the exam.

In addition, the sessions will provide participants with a review of mathematics test content, as well as supplemental test-taking strategies.
