

Project Reach TESOL Program at a Glance

To be eligible for the grant you must have:

1. A Bachelor's Degree and a minimum GPA of 2.5, in order to take the Master's-level courses, or
2. A high school GPA of 3.0 and 60 credit hours in Education in order to take the courses at an undergraduate level; Candidate should be currently taking courses towards their first teaching licensure.
3. An application form (can be downloaded from this web site);
4. Two recommendation letters from the school or district administration if you are a teacher or your professors if you are a college student;
5. A one-page essay to describe how this program will help you in your career.
6. Copies of transcripts from previous courses taken at either graduate or undergraduate level;

To be considered for the grant you must also sit for an interview with members of the advisory committee.

The Project Reach grant covers the tuition for the following seven courses toward an endorsement in TESOL on an existing Ohio teaching license/certificate:

1. EDC 300/500 Diversity in Educational Settings (3 credits)
2. EDL 406/506 Second Language Learning and Pedagogy (3 credits)
3. EDL 407/507 Instructional Methods in TESOL (3 credits)
4. EDL 408/508 Applied Linguistics for Teachers (3 credits)
5. EDL 409/509 Assessment and Evaluation in the ESL/Bilingual Classroom (3 credits)
6. EDL 410/510 Pedagogical Grammar (3 credits)
7. EST 373/573 Practicum in TESOL (3 credits)
