POST-BACCALAUREATE

To apply, students must:

1. Complete an application;
2. Submit official transcript from a regionally-accredited university or college that granted the bachelor's degree, showing the date of receipt of the degree. Students who have previously attended Cleveland State University do not need to submit their CSU transcripts.
3. Remit a nonrefundable \$30 application fee.
