Dr. Anne Galletta was awarded a Dick Boyd Fellowship to participate in Ohio's Education Policy Fellowship Program. This 10-month program promotes leadership among academics and individuals from the public and private sectors committed to improving education. Dr. Galletta is among four selected for the 2009-2010 fellowship class. The Ohio co-sponsors are the Center for Educational Leadership in the College of Education and Human Service and the Lake County Educational Service Center. Dr. Galletta's selection was based in part on a position paper she wrote on the topic "How do districts support schools toward innovation and academic rigor with the intent of strengthening neighborhood schools and bringing bordering, often racially and economically isolated, communities together?" The fellowship is named after Dr. Dick Boyd, a highly-esteemed Ohio educator whose career included positions as Superintendent of Schools in Warren and Lakewood, Ohio, executive director of the Martha Holden Jennings Foundation, deputy state school superintendent in Ohio, and state school superintendent in Mississippi. This annual award was established by Dean Jay McLoughlin in generous support of the Education Policy Fellowship Program and in respect for Dr. Dick Boyd, who is also a contributor to the award.
