Participants will be able to:

1. Understand how to locate opportunities for questions at all levels of Bloom's Taxonomy as they move through their textbooks.
2. Embed high quality standards-aligned assessments into daily instruction.
3. Write interesting and high quality MC, SA, and ER assessments that pinpoint specific instructional needs at each level on Bloom's Taxonomy.
4. Use the items they create to scaffold learning forward, minute-to-minute and day-to-day.
5. Combine the items they create into periodic common assessments.
6. Be able to employ classroom strategies that make students full partners in their own learning.

(Districts can send more than one team – if they want to work at more than one grade level.) **EACH MEMBER OF A SPECIFIC GRADE LEVEL TEAM MUST BRING THE GRADE LEVEL TEXTBOOK TO THE WORKSHOP!**

Cost per 2-day workshop per participant is \$350. Participants can also purchase 1 hour of graduate credit through CSU. The trainer is Donna Snodgrass, Ph.D. of the GCEDC. Dr. Snodgrass is also American Educational Research Association's National Program Chair for *Assessment in Schools*.
