This two-day institute is designed for educators responsible for the induction process either as directors of professional development, coordinators of mentoring programs, school administrators, induction coaches, or as mentors. The goal of the **Mentoring in the 21st Century™** institute is to assist educators in building their capacity for supporting new teachers in ways that help them to be fully qualified and full satisfied.

Fully qualified means that the new teachers and experienced teachers new to the district can demonstrate competency with the professional performance standards identified by the district in which they work and can, therefore, have a significant impact on student learning.

Fully satisfied means that the new teachers and experienced teachers new to the district feel supported, valued, and productive as people and as professional educators and, therefore not only stay in the teaching profession but continue to teach in the schools to which they are assigned.

Brenda Kaylor is a Senior Consultant for Just ASK Publications and Professional Development. She is the former director of Professional Development in the St. Vrain Valley School District in Longmont, Colorado. Much of her focus while in that position was to accelerate the learning of teachers, principals, mentors and instructional coaches. In this position, Brenda developed a structure for system-wide professional development that mirrored the expectations for differentiation and choice in the classroom. She is the editor of the publication **Results-Based Professional Development Models**. Brenda currently works with schools and districts across the nation as they reform their instructional work to meet 21st century demands.
