

Statistical Concepts with Applications (MTH 147)

Prerequisite: A grade of 'SC' or better in MTH 087 or suitable placement-test score. A first course in statistics that emphasizes statistical methodology as applied in the social and behavioral sciences, education, and business; topics include descriptive statistics, elementary probability, elementary sampling theory, estimation, hypothesis testing, regression and correlation. Students who earn credit for MTH 147 cannot earn subsequent credit for MTH 116.
