Fenn Academy scholarships are made available through the generous support of Corporate Sponsors and the Cleveland State University Honors Program.

Parker Hannifin Scholarships

Parker Hannifin – Fenn Academy Scholarship

Amount: Ten \$2,000 Parker Hannifin-Fenn Academy Scholarships to be paid toward first semester tuition at CSU. This is a one-time (one-year per recipient) award.

The Parker Hannifin Donald Washkewicz – Fenn Academy Scholarship

Amount: One \$5,000 Donald Washkewicz-Fenn Academy Scholarship to be paid to an engineering student toward tuition at CSU up to four years. This award is renewable for four consecutive years, based on a minimum grade point average of 3.0 and full-time status. The total amount for this award shall not exceed \$20,000.

Eligibility: Fenn Scholars must be admitted to CSU Fenn College of Engineering. The selection of recipients will be based on ACT/SAT score(s), high school cumulative G.P.A., essay, and recommendation letter. A minimum ACT score of 29 is required for eligibility of the Donald Washkewicz Fenn Academy Scholarship. The recipient of the Donald Washkewicz Fenn Academy Scholarship is not eligible to receive more than one Fenn Academy scholarship award.

Middough Consulting Scholarships

Middough Consulting – Fenn Academy Scholarship

Amount: Four \$2,000 Middough Consulting-Fenn Academy Scholarships to be paid toward the first semester tuition at Cleveland State University. This is a one-time (one-year per recipient) award.

The Middough Consulting Ronald Ledin – Fenn Academy Scholarship

Amount: One tuition scholarship award for a Fenn Academy student to be paid in the amount of \$5,000 for the first year, and \$2,000 for the next three consecutive years, pending eligibility. This scholarship also includes \$250 per year for textbooks during the four-year duration of the scholarship for a total of \$1,200. The total amount of this award (scholarship and books) is not to exceed \$12,000.

Eligibility: Fenn Scholars must be admitted to CSU Fenn College of Engineering. The selection of recipients will be based on ACT/SAT score(s), high school cumulative G.P.A., essay, and recommendation letter. A minimum ACT score of 28 is required for eligibility of the Ronald Ledin Fenn Academy Scholarship. The recipient of the Ronald Ledin award is not eligible to receive more than one Fenn Academy scholarship award.

Lubrizol Corporation Scholarship

Lubrizol Corporation – Fenn Academy Scholarship

Amount: \$4,000 renewable scholarships awards to Fenn Academy high school seniors majoring in mechanical, chemical, or electrical engineering. The scholarships may be renewable based on maintenance of a minimum 3.0 g.p.a. for up to 8 semesters or 4 years of full-time enrollment.

Amount: \$2,000 one-time scholarships to Fenn Academy high school seniors who are interested in majoring in mechanical, chemical, or electrical engineering.

Eligibility: Fenn Scholars must be admitted to CSU Fenn College of Engineering. The selection of recipients will be based on ACT/SAT score(s), high school cumulative G.P.A., essay, and recommendation letter. The recipient of a Lubrizol Corporation award is not eligible to receive more than one Fenn Academy scholarship award.

Great Lakes Construction Company Scholarship

Great Lakes Construction Company – Fenn Academy Scholarship

Amount: One \$1,500 scholarship award to a Fenn Academy high school senior majoring in civil engineering. The award may be renewable to the same student based on eligibility or may be given to a new Fenn Academy student each year.

Eligibility: Fenn Scholars must be admitted to CSU Fenn College of Engineering. The selection of a recipient will be based on ACT/SAT score(s), high school cumulative G.P.A., essay, and recommendation letter.

HONORS PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIPS

Amount: Two Honors Program scholarships to cover tuition, books and academic fees are awarded to two top engineering students from the Fenn Academy admitted to the CSU Honors Program who meet or exceed the Honors Program eligibility criteria.

Eligibility: 30 ACT Composite score or above **OR**
1300 SAT total score (old test), 1950 SAT total score (new test) or above **OR**
Top 10 percent high school class ranking
Submission of a written essay
