Frank J. Ambrose Scholarship Competition Day
Saturday, December 4, 2004*

The Frank J. Ambrose award is a full four-year undergraduate tuition scholarship to the Fenn College of Engineering at Cleveland State University. This prestigious scholarship is awarded to graduating high school seniors who are Ohio residents. To be eligible for consideration, the student must rank in the top 10 percent of his/her graduating class or have a minimum grade point average of 3.5, an ACT score of 24 (or SAT of 1090) or better, and take the exam on the Frank J. Ambrose Scholarship Competition Day. The exam will test aptitude in engineering, science, math, and problem-solving.

The Competition Day

The Frank J. Ambrose Competition Day will be held December 4, 2004 on the campus of Cleveland State University in Stilwell Hall, Compton Lounge, Room 103. Parents are invited to attend an informational session about financial aid and Cleveland State University. The schedule for the day is as follows:

9:00-9:30 a.m.	Check in, continental breakfast, welcome
9:30-11:00 a.m.	Exam for students Information session for parents
11:00-noon	Tour of engineering labs. Meet engineering faculty, staff, and students

Exam

The exam will be one and a half hours in length. No books or notes are permitted. Bring a calculator (without keyboard) and two pencils. The exam consists of a series of questions related to various engineering situations. Although knowledge of algebra, geometry, and chemistry is needed, the exam does not simply test knowledge of these subjects. Rather, the exam will test the ability of the student to apply these mathematical and scientific concepts to real-world engineering problems, such as bridge design, food processing, water treatment, and vehicle design, among others.

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Selection Criteria

The Frank J. Ambrose scholarships will be awarded based on a combination of several factors including: the score of the competition exam; high school course selection; grade point average; ACT and/or SAT scores; and extracurricular activities. To be eligible to receive the scholarship, the student must complete the admission process highlighted below in item number three.

Ambrose Registration Procedure

1. Complete and submit the following Ambrose registration form by November 24, 2004. Forms received after this date will be accepted on a first-come first-served basis. You will then receive confirmation of your registration, directions to the event, and parking arrangements. Register on-line, or mail your registration form to:

2. Attend the Competition Day on December 4, 2004 and take the exam.
3. Submit your application to the CSU Admissions Office, including official transcripts, ACT/SAT scores, and the \$30 application fee no later than January 7, 2005. Applying earlier is recommended. Mail your CSU application to:
