

INFORMATION FOR A NON-DEGREE GRADUATE STUDENT

A graduate student is defined by Cleveland State University as an individual who holds a baccalaureate or a more advanced degree. This student may enroll in graduate courses at Cleveland State University without being formally admitted to a graduate degree, certificate or licensure program.

To apply as a Non-Degree Graduate, a completed Application for Graduate Admission Form must be completed which indicates the receipt of an earned baccalaureate degree.

Non-Degree Graduate Students cannot borrow in excess of the loan borrowing limits in place for undergraduate students:

- \$23,000 for dependent students
- \$46,000 for independent students (no more than \$ 23,000 of this amount in undergraduate subsidized loans)
