

## 2009-2010 Verification Worksheet - Dependent

Your application was selected for review in a process called "Verification." In this process, your school will be comparing information from your application with signed copies of 2008 Federal Tax Forms, W-2 forms, and/or other financial documents of yours and your parent/s. The law says we have the right to ask you for this information before awarding aid. If there are differences between your application information and your financial documents, you or your school may need to make corrections electronically or by using your Student Aid Report (SAR).

Complete this verification form and submit it to your financial aid administrator as soon as possible, so that your financial aid won't be delayed. Your financial aid administrator will help you.

### What you should do

2. Talk to your financial aid administrator if you have any questions about completing this worksheet.
3. Complete and sign the worksheet - you and at least one parent.
4. Submit the completed worksheet, tax forms, and any other documents requested to your financial aid administrator.
5. Your financial aid administrator will compare information on this worksheet and any supporting documents with the information you submitted on your application. You or your school may need to make corrections electronically or by using your SAR.
