



“Forever Buckeye” Ohio Residency Application

Ohio’s FY 2012-2013 budget establishes a new provision called "Forever Buckeye." This provision extends the in-state tuition rate to Ohio high school graduates having the current legal status to remain permanently in the United States, who had left Ohio but who return to enroll in an Ohio public institution of higher education *and* who establish a primary residence in Ohio by the 1st day of classes of the requested term.

Documentation received after the start of the term will be processed for the following term. Faxed copies will not be accepted. The Registrar’s Office may require additional documentation prior to making a determination regarding your "Forever Buckeye" Ohio residency eligibility.

The following documents must be submitted with this form: a copy each of a) your Ohio high school transcript or a verification of your graduation on the high school's letterhead stationery; and b) your current housing lease or property deed. (Note: a copy of a high school diploma is **not** sufficient evidence of high school graduation.) **If you are not a U.S. citizen, you must attach a copy of supporting documents establishing your current immigration or Visa status.**
