INTRODUCTION

The Executive MBA (EMBA) program at the Cleveland State University Nance College of Business brings together the curriculum, faculty, exceptional students and hands-on experience to change how you work, think and lead. It is where business concepts and professional practice come together in one powerful learning experience.

The management skills and techniques gained in our EMBA program are immediately applicable at work and form the basis for long-term career growth as you become a more effective strategic thinker and leader.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The EMBA program is scheduled in a lock-step format. Classes are delivered in sequence to help you build skills and knowledge logically, while providing a cooperative learning experience through the cohort based format where you take classes with the same group of students throughout the program.

The program focuses on cross-functional, globally-oriented courses that integrate several disciplines into one unified topic. The program also emphasizes ethics, compliance, and corporate social responsibility to strengthen your leadership skills. The program begins in late August with a six-day retreat. Classes are

then held on most Saturdays and an occasional Friday (you have some Saturdays free) through the Fall, Spring, and Summer terms, followed by a four week break in August. The EMBA program includes 12-day international business study tour of businesses in an emerging market. The carefully planned schedule enables you to complete the EMBA program in just 19 months.



RESEARCH

The EMBA program begins with a six-day residency retreat built around a comprehensive case analysis. Core courses build breadth and depth of knowledge in the functional areas of business. The 12-day International Business Study Tour brings meaningful focus through extensive research on one particular industry and firm, while valuable breadth is gained through visits to a variety of organizations within one country. The program culminates with the Business Practicum where you'll be immersed in real-world projects for area organizations.
