\* Electives will be either three or four semester hours depending upon the course assigned. If three hour electives are chosen, the class will meet for 10 weeks, four hour electives will meet for 13 weeks.

Classes shown on Monday and Wednesday may be interchanged due to availability of assigned faculty.

**IMPORTANT:**

Beginning November 1, 2006, students who are non-Progressive employees enjoy the opportunity to be allowed to attend classes at the Progressive facilities and as a result, students will need to pay a one-time facilities fee of \$30 for a background check (payable to Progressive Direct Insurance Company). **The background check is in a manner consistent with Fair Credit Reporting Act and will NOT be used to check for financial disclosure.**

Please keep in mind that off-campus students pay the regular CSU fees but do not have to pay for parking each semester. The \$30 fee for the background check is about 1/3 of the cost of the regular semester parking fees at CSU.
