



IFSA Foundation Study Abroad Scholarship for Non-Traditional Students

PURPOSE

To provide financial assistance to non-traditional, full-time, degree seeking undergraduate students at Cleveland State for study abroad for a semester or academic year. Scholarships may be awarded up to \$5,000 per semester of study abroad.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

In order to qualify for the IFSA Foundation Study Abroad Scholarship for Non-Traditional Students, students must meet the following criteria **at the time of application**:

1. Enrolled full-time (12 credits) in a degree granting program at the undergraduate level at Cleveland State University;
2. Aged 25 or older
3. Successful completion of at least 2 semesters at Cleveland State
4. Minimum overall GPA of 2.75 or higher
5. Demonstrated financial need with current FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) on file in the Office of Financial Aid

APPLICATION

Complete applications must be turned into Center for International Services and Programs (KB1150). Students who do not meet all of the eligibility requirements will be disqualified. A complete application will include:

1. Application form
2. Statement of Purpose
3. 1 academic letter of reference.
4. If you have not filed a FAFSA, a completed FAFSA form should be turned in with this application

DEADLINES

Fall 2009 and Academic Year 2009-2010 **May 15, 2009**
Spring 2010 **October 15, 2009**

SELECTION PROCESS

The committee will base its decision and award amounts on the following criteria:

1. Statement of Purpose
2. Letter of Recommendation
3. CSU Campus and Greater Cleveland community involvement and volunteer work
4. Demonstrated financial need

SERVICE COMPONENT

Upon their return to the U.S., scholarship recipients are required to get involved in the promotion of study abroad programming at CSU. This could be fulfilled in numerous ways: donation of personal study abroad photos for use in publications (digital or paper), linking from the CISP website to a personal blog about the overseas experience, presentations to prospective study abroad students at meetings or events sponsored by the Center for International Services and Programs, or serving as a “student profile” student on our web page.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

Please write a statement of purpose that addresses the following questions in 500 words or more:

1. Where and why do you want to study abroad? Please list your program choice and/or university and the semester(s) and year in which you intend to study abroad.
2. Describe how the IFSA Foundation Scholarship would help you to study abroad. What would you use the scholarship money specifically for?
3. How does study abroad relate to your professional, personal, and academic goals?
4. Please discuss your current (within the last year) involvement on the CSU campus (such as student organizations)? What kind of unpaid community service have you done in the greater Cleveland community in the past year? Please include the name of each organization and the type of service work that you do.
5. State your plan to fulfill the service component of the scholarship.

LETTER OF REFERENCE

We suggest asking a faculty member who knows you and your work. You can tell the recommender that they are welcome to email or mail their reference into the Center for International Services and Programs, KB 1150 or studyabroad@csuohio.edu. The reference should address in one page your skills, qualities, and suitability to receive up to a \$5,000 study abroad scholarship. You may wish to give your professor a copy of your statement of purpose to assist them in writing your reference.
