Explore commonalities in effecting health and wellness through an integrative approach of mind, body, and spiritual wellness in the context of a healthy environment.

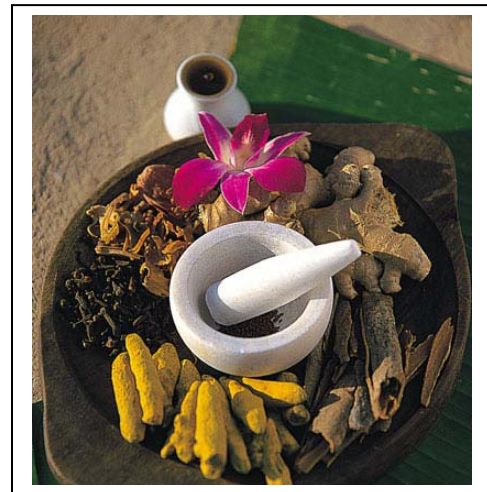
