

The Department of Chemistry at Case Western Reserve University invites applications for a temporary teaching appointment for the 2009 summer session. The appointment will involve principal responsibility for teaching the organic lecture course, CHEM 223/224. The 2009 summer session runs from June 1 until July 31. Candidates should have a Ph. D, preferably in organic chemistry; preference will be given to persons with demonstrated experience in teaching organic chemistry.
