The CSU Speech and Hearing Clinic offers a range of services from consultation to comprehensive diagnostic and therapy services for children, teens, and adults with speech, language, and hearing problems. Individual or group therapy is available.



Speech & Language Services

Diagnostic and Treatment:

Speech

Fees

Reasonable fees are charged for all services.

- ◆ The CSU Speech and Hearing Clinic is Medicaid and Medicare approved. The Clinic does not bill private insurance companies directly but we will assist you in completing your insurance forms.
- ◆ Reduced fees (based on family size and income) are available for eligible clients. Fees are automatically reduced for CSU employees, students, and families of employees and students.

Services are provided by CSU Graduate Students under supervision of professionals licensed by the state of Ohio and certified by the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association.



Clinic Hours

Monday 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.
Tue/Wed/Thu 9 a.m. - 8 p.m.
Friday 9 a.m. - 12 p.m.

Therapy sessions are typically one hour. Speech-language and aural rehabilitation clients are usually scheduled for two therapy sessions per week, Mondays/Wednesdays or Tuesdays/Thursdays.
