- O I was a <u>noncitizen who entered the U.S. AFTER the age of 26.</u> If you entered the United States for the first time after your 26th birthday, you must provide documentation to support your claim. **Submit the following information:**
 - This form, AND
 - Valid documentation from the list below:
 - Entry stamp in your passport when you came into this country for the first time after your 26th birthday.
 - o I-94 with entry stamp on it,
 - o A letter from the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Service (USCIS) indicating the date you entered the United States.
 - If you entered the United States illegally <u>after</u> your 26th birthday, you must provide proof that you were not living in the United States from age 18 to age 25.
 Please note: your Resident Alien Card (Green Card) is not valid as proof of entry to the United
 - A copy of the Selective Service Status Information Letter (SIL) is required. Visit http://www.sss.gov/instructions.html for additional information or call 1-847-688-6888.
- O I was a <u>lawful non-immigrant</u> who entered the U.S. <u>BEFORE</u> the age of 26. If you entered the United States as a valid non-immigrant alien, and remained in that status until your 26th birthday, you must provide documentation to support your claim. Submit the following information:

 - Valid documentation from the list below:

- F1 Student Visa- if you entered the United States as an F-1 Student, and remained in that status until your 26th birthday, you would need to provide documentation indicating that you were admitted on an F-1 visa and attended school full-time as required. (Acceptable documents for this situation includes copies of your I-20 or a letter from the school you attended indicating your full time attendance as a non-immigrant alien).
- o Other non-immigrant statuses. You must submit documentation of your status when you entered the U.S. You must explain, if at any point, you violated the terms of your visa, or overstayed your visa and became an undocumented alien.
