



3344-83-07 Interim suspension.

- (A) Prior to the holding or completion of a hearing by the judicial board or the student conduct officer (“SCO”), or the rendering of a decision by either, the status within the university of the student or student organization should not be altered except in exceptional circumstances involving the likelihood of serious danger to the health and/or safety of persons or property or disruption of the educational process. In such extraordinary circumstances, the president or the president's designee may order an interim suspension of the student or student organization.
- (B) Within twenty-four hours of such suspension, or as soon as possible prior to such action, the president or president's designee shall cause notice of the suspension, explaining why the suspension cannot await a hearing, to be mailed by certified mail to the last known address of the student or student organization and to the university appeal board. Within three working days of any interim suspension, the university appeal board shall review the facts and the reasons for the suspension, and shall make recommendations to the president as to whether or not the suspension under this provision should remain in effect prior to the final determination of the case by the judicial board or SCO.
