### **Prospective Transfer:** (Students not admitted to CSU)

The CSU Partnership Coordinator is able to meet with students and provide unofficial transcript evaluations to review transferrable credits. Transcript evaluations can be provided for any major at CSU.

### **Admitted CSU Partnership Students:**

College advisors are available by appointment to meet with current admitted partnership program students.
