

How to setup Microsoft Outlook on an Android Phone/Tablet

1. To begin, you must go to the Google Play Store. Search for **Microsoft Outlook**. Install the app.



2. Open the app and scroll through all the introductory screens until you reach a screen like the following, press **Get Started.**



3. Select **Exchange** from the Screen and enter in your CSU email and Campus Password. Another screen will appear and enter the following:

Email Address: Your CSU email address@csuohio.edu

Example:

j.smith @vikes.csuohio.edu-students

j.doe@csuohio.edu - faculty/staff

Domain: it is recommended to leave this blank

Server: outlook.office365.com

Username: Your CSU ID # @ csuohio.edu

Example:

2345678@vikes.csuohio.edu – students

1234567@csuohio.edu - faculty/staff

Password: your CSU email password

Name: Whatever you choose to call your email account (optional)

Uninstalling Outlook

1. Open up **Settings**. Then select **Security**.

2. Select **Device administrators**
