CONFUCIUS INSTITUTE STUDY ABROAD SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION CRITERIA & INFORMATION

The all-inclusive program fee is \$7,500. The Confucius Institute offers two levels of Study Abroad Scholarship:

- Level I: A scholarship of **\$5,300**, which covers all expenses in China. The final program fee you pay is \$2,200.
- Level II: A scholarship of **\$3,600**, which covers all tuitions in China. The final program fee you pay is \$3,900.

The factors that determines your scholarship include your GPA, past coursework, past participation in Chinese language and culture activities, and how you will benefit from participating in this program.

The following items need to be submitted in order to be considered for the CI scholarships:

- 1) A signed copy of this scholarship application form.
- 2) A signed copy of the program registration form.
- 3) Evidence of your Chinese language proficiency (e.g., HSK exam test certificate, unofficial transcript)
- 4) A copy of your **unofficial** transcript showing your cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above.
- 5) Submit names, title, and contact information (phone and e-mail) of two references (at least one must be faculty at the applicant's home university).

- 6) Write an essay (no more than two single-spaced typed pages) describing your knowledge of Chinese language and culture and the Confucius Institute, and explaining how you will benefit from this program.

Applications for the Confucius Institute Scholarships are due in RT 1214A to Dr. Haigang Zhou by **Friday, January 30, 2015.**
