Email

CSU provides all faculty with a free email account. Faculty can access Engage 365 through a web browser or Outlook client. Set-up information and training resources are available on our website under *Messaging and Collaboration Services, Email-Engage 365*.

Anti-Virus for your Personally Owned Computer

Keeping your computer virus-free is pretty important. We recommend you download Microsoft Security Essentials at http://windows.microsoft.com/en-us/windows/security-essentials-download.

Wireless Networks

All of the CSU campus except for a few parking areas is wireless. To use the wireless network, you need a laptop, wireless card, and your CSU ID and CampusNet password. Instructions for set-up are available online. If you have any issues configuring or accessing the wireless network, please make an appointment to meet with a technician (216-687-5050). Guest Wireless (csuguest) access is also available for visitors to the university.

VPN Services

VPN allows you to connect to campus resources from anywhere and is required to access your desktop remotely. VPN services are automatically provided for full-time faculty and are available upon request to other faculty. Cellular Services

We offer cellular phone services through negotiated service providers. 

What's On The Web?

CampusNet

You can access class rosters, enter student grades, check course schedules, set up your CSU Alert information, etc., via CampusNet. Through CampusNet, you can send email to students in your classes. Contact the Help Desk at 216-687-5050 if you don't know your CSU ID or CampusNet Password. To access CampusNet go to the myCSU webpage at http://mycsu.csuohio.edu and click on *CampusNet*.

Blackboard

Blackboard is the course management system used at CSU. Blackboard helps faculty build and deploy courses online and engage with students interactively. Faculty who wish to use Blackboard will need to contact the Center for eLearning at 216-687-3960 to get started.

Research Capabilities Online

As members of an Ohio university, CSU faculty members are eligible to apply for resources on the *Ohio Supercomputer Center (OSC)* at no cost. OSC is a state-funded center in Columbus that maintains state-of-the-art computer facilities for use by higher education. Computer time is granted by proposal, and the Center maintains licenses for a variety of software packages, programming languages, and libraries.

Faculty Profile is an online application designed to showcase information about CSU faculty and provide a uniform look to faculty profiles across all colleges. Faculty can maintain their information through a web-based application found at https://updatefacultyprofile.csuohio.edu.

Employee Self-Service

on the employee's job classification, this system is used to clock in/out, report time worked or exception time taken (sick or vacation).

myProfile is a web-based application that allows employees to:

- View and update employee-specific information such as address, emergency contact, phone and email.
- View paycheck, leave accrual, direct deposit and W2 information.
- View a summary of current benefit elections, plan coverage, covered dependents and beneficiaries.

CSU Alert

In case of an emergency, the university may send information from the CSU Alert System via phone, email, or text. Emergency messages are only broadcast by the authority of the University President, Provost, or select members of the Campus Safety division. Situations include, but are not limited to, campus closings (weather, utilities, etc.), building emergencies (utilities, HAZMAT incident, major fire, etc.), potential life-threatening situations on campus, activation of emergency response teams, etc. To sign up for CSU Alert, log in to CampusNet using your CSU ID and CampusNet password and click on the *Sign Up* button to enter your information.
