FINANCIAL AID CONSORTIUM

Partnership students are eligible to receive financial aid. However, students can only receive financial aid from one school at a time (per semester). Cleveland State University will process your financial aid based on the number of credit hours you are enrolled in solely with CSU.

Financial Aid Consortium Agreements: Partnership students who are dually enrolled at both Lorain County Community College (LCCC) and Cleveland State University (CSU), who wish to have their financial aid cover their total enrollment between the two schools **MUST** complete a financial aid consortium agreement.

- Consortium Agreements must be completed each semester that a student wishes to receive aid for their dual enrollment.
- Eligibility to use the consortium form requires that students are admitted as a degree seeking partnership students in a partnership program. It also requires that students are enrolled in at least one (1) Cleveland State University class for the semester in which they are using the consortium agreement.
- Consortium agreements can only be found online through the LCCC University Partnership [website](#) or in the CSU Partnership Office.
- Students must also have Cleveland State University listed on their current FAFSA in order for CSU to process their aid.
