3344-15-01 Office of research.

- (A) The office of research is established at Cleveland state university. The office of research shall be led by the vice president for research.
- (B) A university research council shall be established to advise the vice president of research on the development of internally funded research support incentive programs, as well as research strategies and policies that are designed to enhance the University's commitment to basic and applied research.
 - (1) The university research council shall adopt bylaws to govern its membership, officers, meetings, committees and specific functions.
 - (2) To be eligible to serve on the university research council, faculty members must be well-recognized scholars as indicated by external funding, nationally recognized research or other appropriate indicators.
- (C) For the purposes of this rule, the term "research" refers to all research, scholarship, and creative activity at Cleveland state university.
