WALTER B. WAETJEN AWARD

ESTABLISHED IN HONOR OF FORMER CSU PRESIDENT WALTER B. WAETJEN

CRITERIA: Excellence in scholastic achievement; a CSU student who is completing his or her junior year; at least a 3.7 GPA with preference given to full-time day students who have earned at least half of their credits at CSU.

CSU WOMEN'S ALUMNAE SCHOLARSHIP

ESTABLISHED WITH FUNDS PROVIDED BY THE FORMER CSU ALUMNAE ASSOCIATION

CRITERIA: Given to an outstanding junior woman for use in her senior year; rotates alphabetically throughout the undergraduate colleges; given for recognition of scholastic ability; full-time student taking a minimum of 12 credit hours who began her academic career at CSU.

LEE J. MULL AND DONALD P. MULL SCHOLARSHIP

ESTABLISHED IN MEMORY OF FORMER CSU ALUMNI ASSOCIATION PRESIDENT, LEE J. MULL, '75/'80

CRITERIA: Excellence in scholastic achievement and service to the University; full-time woman student entering her senior year with a GPA of 3.0 for law students and 3.7 for all others; majority of the credits must have been earned at CSU; rotates between the Cleveland-Marshall College of Law and the Departments of Music and Political Science.

BUSINESS ALUMNI ORGANIZATION DEAN PAUL R. ANDERS SCHOLARSHIP

ESTABLISHED IN HONOR OF PAUL R. ANDERS, FORMER DEAN OF THE COLLEGE OF BUSINESS AT FENN COLLEGE, PREDECESSOR TO CLEVELAND STATE UNIVERSITY

CRITERIA: Must be a student in the James J. Nance College of Business Administration in his/her freshman year at CSU; based on scholarship, not financial need.

MAXINE GOODMAN LEVIN COLLEGE OF URBAN AFFAIRS ALUMNI ORGANIZATION SCHOLARSHIP

ESTABLISHED IN 1993 TO RECOGNIZE ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE IN STUDENTS WITH AN INTEREST IN PURSUING A CAREER IN URBAN STUDIES, URBAN PLANNING, OR PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

CRITERIA: Must be an undergraduate student within one semester of completing his or her sophomore year, with the two most recent semesters having been completed at Cleveland State University, and be a declared major in the Levin College. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 at time of application.

CSUAA ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP FOR LEADERSHIP

ESTABLISHED BY THE CSU ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

CRITERIA: Given to a student who is currently enrolled at Cleveland State University and has achieved a GPA of 3.0 or higher, attained sophomore rank and is actively serving in a leadership capacity in an academic, civic, or social organization. One faculty member and one administrator who are familiar with the candidate's leadership ability must recommend the student(s).
