Child Development Center Advisory Committee – Charge and Composition

The Child Development Center Advisory Committee makes its recommendations to the Vice President of Business Affairs and Finance and is charged with the following responsibilities:

- Review and provide constituent input on long-range plans for child care at the University.
- Review and provide constituent input on rates for child care as necessary to ensure a self-supporting operation.
- Assist in publicizing child care issues and developments within the University community.
- Review the Center's annual goals and objectives.

The committee membership is comprised of:

- One faculty member annually appointed by the Faculty Senate
- One Undergraduate student annually appointed by the Student Government Association
- One representative annually appointed from the Management Administrative Staff
 Association
- Three to five parents representing the diversity of the Center's current enrollment (Community, Employee/Alumni and Student)
- Director of the Child Development Center [non-voting]
- Assistant Vice President for Campus Support Services or designee Chair
