
Handy Tip for Improving Classroom Engagement Class Rosters with Photos

You probably already knew this – but making it a point to address your students by name is a simple way to improve classroom engagement. For most of us, the hard part is learning all of those names, especially in the case of large classes.

Did you know that you can now get your class rosters with student photos included? It's not perfect – some few students are still listed without images – but it's extremely helpful in matching names with faces as you begin the semester.

Here's how you do it:

- 1. Log into CampusNet.
- Choose the "Instructor" tab, and select "Class Rosters" for the semester in question. You sl see a list of all your rosters for that semester.
- 3. Click the "open" link for the roster in question. You should see a list (without pictures) of all students currently entor



for this class.

4. Look closely at the top area of the screen as you view your list of students. There should be a link visible up there for "Roster with Pictures".
