INVITATION TO VIETNAM ERA VETERANS AND OTHER PROTECTED VETERANS

Invitation

Cleveland State University has an affirmative action program to employ and advance in employment qualified veterans of the Vietnam era. If you are a Vietnam era veteran and would like to be considered under this affirmative action program, please tell us so that we may assist and respond to your needs. Submission of this information is voluntary and refusal to provide it will not subject you to adverse treatment. You may inform us of your desire to benefit under the program at this time and/or at any time in the future.

Other Protected Veterans and recently separated veterans are also entitled to benefits under this program. You may inform us of your desire to benefit under this program at this time and/or at any time in the future.

Definitions

“Veteran of the Vietnam-era” means a person who: (A) served on active duty for a period of more than 180 days, and was discharged or released therefrom with other than a dishonorable discharge, if any part of such active duty occurred: (I) in the Republic of Vietnam between February 28, 1961 and May 7, 1975; or (II) between August 5, 1964 and May 7, 1975, in all other cases, or (B) was discharged or released from active duty for a service-connected disability if any part of such active duty was performed (I) in the Republic of Vietnam between February 28, 1961 and May 7, 1975: or (II) between August 5, 1964 and May 7, 1975 in all other cases.

“Other Protected Veterans” means veterans who served in active duty during a war or in a campaign or expedition for which a campaign badge has been authorized, other than disabled veterans or veterans of the Vietnam Era.
