Financial Requirements for International Students Cleveland State University 2013-2014

All international students must show financial (tuition and living expenses) **support for one academic year.** Financial documentation must be presented in order for Cleveland State University to issue an I-20 (F-1) or DS 2019 (J-1) form. The financial verification and I-20 or DS 2019 must be presented at the U.S. Embassy or consulate when applying for either an F-1 or J-1 Visa. Please have two original financial documents prepared:

- One for Cleveland State University and
- One to present to the U.S. Embassy or Consulate.

All documentation MUST be original, dated and issued within the past year.

The following documents or a combination are acceptable:

- 1. An original bank statement in your name, which indicates the amount of funds available.
- 2. An original bank statement in your guarantor's name (sponsor or parent) that indicates the amount available accompanied by a letter of confirmation from the guarantor of his or her intention to provide support. The bank statement MUST indicate a minimum amount held in the account, on bank stationary with a telephone, FAX number and street address.
- An Affidavit of Support (I-134 form) if your sponsor is a US citizen or Permanent Resident of the U.S. The form can be obtained from our office or it can be downloaded at: <u>http://uscis.gov/graphics/formsfee/forms/index.htm</u> Item #11 must be completed with the sponsor's specific financial intentions.
- 4. A letter from your guarantor's employer accompanied by a letter from the guarantor confirming his or her intention to provide support. The guarantor's salary must show his/her ability to provide the amount of the promised support.
- 5. A letter of support from your government or other sponsoring agency that indicates the amount available and additional provisions, such as health insurance coverage. Please provide a signed copy of the award letter with billing instructions. You should also send a copy to the Office of Treasury Services on campus once you arrive in order for the billing to take place.
