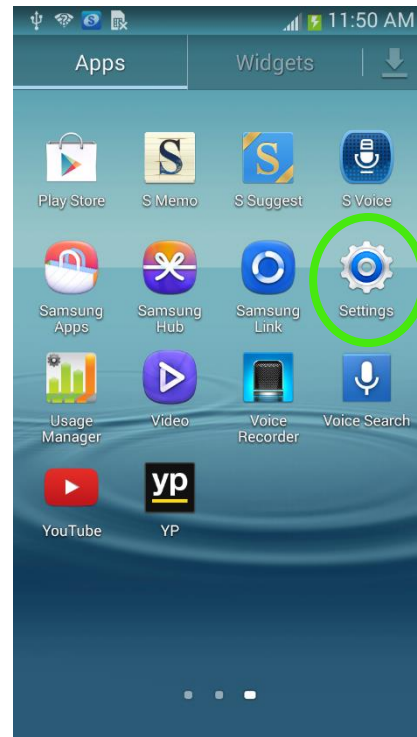
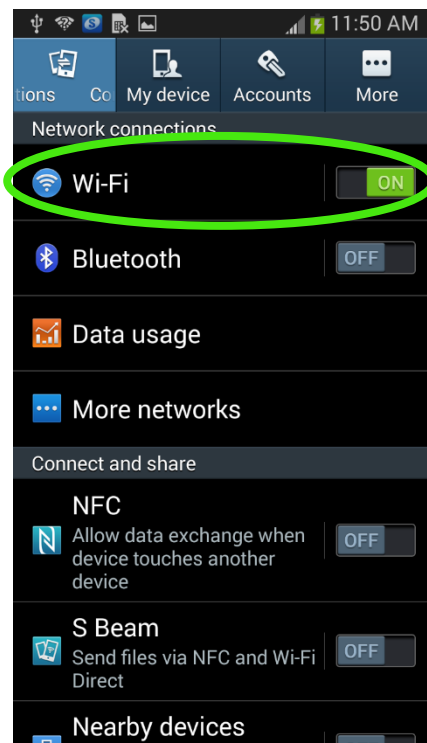


How to access “4csuuseonly” wireless on Android Phones/Tablets

1. Depending on your smartphone, go to the **phone’s settings**.



2. Tap **Wi-Fi**.
 - a. If Wi-Fi is not turned on, tap the On/Off switch next to Wi-Fi.



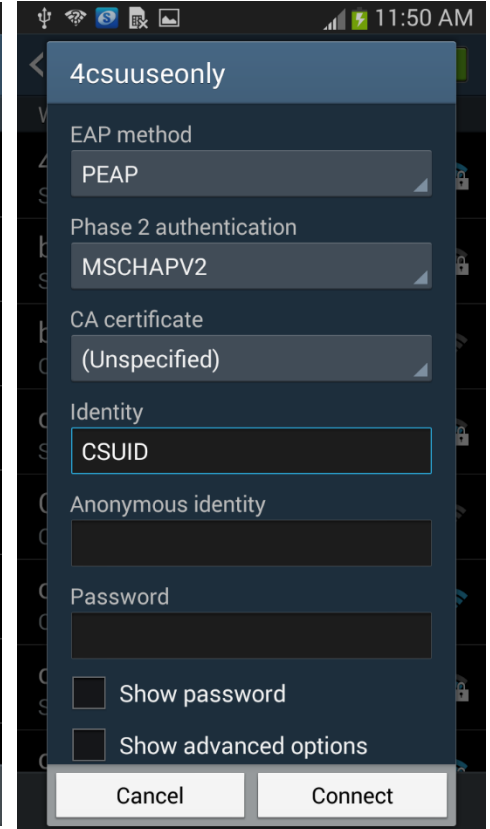
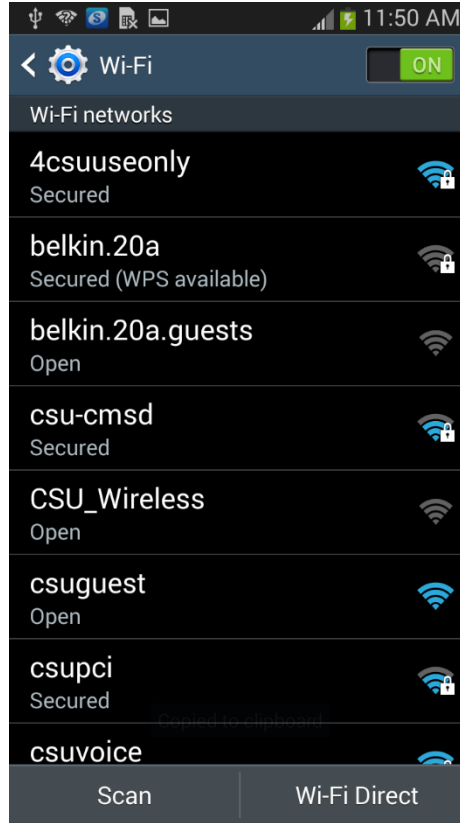
3. Tap on **4csuuseonly** and use these settings.

4. Tap “Phase 2 authentication” and change it to **MSCHAPV2**.

5. Enter your **CSUID** under Identity. Note: Don’t enter anything under “Anonymous identity”.

6. Enter your **CampusNet Password** under password.

7. Tap **Connect**.
