3344-15-01 Bylaws of the office Office of research.

- (A) (Revisions approved by faculty senate May 1, 2013, approved by board of trustees May 20, 2013.)
- (B) These bylaws are applicable within the authorization

The office of research is established by the bylaws of the board of trustees and the faculty organization of at Cleveland state university.

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This organization shall be known as the <u>The</u> office of research at <u>Cleveland state</u> university.

3344-15-03 University research council.

- (A) The university research council shall consist of:
 - (A) (1) Fifteen faculty or staff members eligible under paragraph (B) of this rule, two from each of the seven academic colleges and one from the school of nursing. Eligible faculty and staff members shall be nominated by the deans of their respective colleges and submitted to shall be led by the vice president for research.
 - (B) A university research council shall be established to advise the vice president of research on the development of internally funded research support incentive programs, as well as research strategies and policies that are designed to enhance the University's commitment to basic and applied research.
 - (1) The university research council shall adopt bylaws to govern its membership, officers, meetings, committees and specific functions.
- <u>To be (2)</u> A representative elected annually by the graduate faculty during regular elections to serve as a member of, and liaison to, eligible to serve on the university research council.
- (3) The director of sponsored programs and research services.
 - (B) Eligible, faculty and staff: members
 - (1)(2) To be must be well-recognized scholars as indicated by external funding, nationally recognized research or other appropriate indicators.
- (C) The university research council shall be charged with For the following responsibilities:

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- (B) (C) (1) Research policies. Review and reportpurposes of this rule, the term "research" refers to the faculty, deans, and the provost on all proposals for new policies or programs designed to enhance research productivity and success, scholarship, and creative activity at Cleveland state university.
- (2) Internal funding programs. Review and recommend changes to the vice president for research on internal funding programs for research. The university research council will also be requested to participate in reviewing proposals for internal competitions, ranking the proposals and forwarding recommendations for funding to the vice president for research.
- (3) Bylaws of the university research council. The university research council shall develop bylaws and procedures.
- (4) Committees. Appointment and discharge of such committees as deemed appropriate. These committees may include members outside the council, including external to the university, as appropriate.

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
