



2018 Transportation Engineer Scholarship

The ASHE Lake Erie Section will be offering a scholarship to a student in a transportation or construction related program. The eligibility requirements and amount of the awards are listed below but may be amended as necessary by the Board or Scholarship Committee.

Amount

One scholarship in the amount of \$1,500 will be awarded in February 2019

Eligibility

- Minimum GPA of 2.5.
 - The applicant shall be a college student in a civil engineering or construction related program.
 - The applicant must be attending the following universities: Case Western Reserve University, Cleveland State University or John Carroll University
- or**
- be a full-time resident within the ASHE Lake Erie Region (Cuyahoga, Geauga, Lake, Lorain and Medina Counties) and enrolled at a university.
- The applicant must be a citizen of the United States or have permanent resident status.
 - The applicant is eligible to receive this award only one time.
 - Students who previously applied for the scholarship and were not recipients are strongly encouraged to resubmit an application for review.
 - The applicant must not receive more than 75% funding (grant or scholarship) from other sources towards the cost of tuition.
 - The applicant may be requested to meet with the Scholarship Committee for a personal interview.
