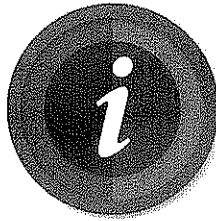

Inspects existing waste treatment and disposal facilities for stable control devices. Coordinates the collection of other data related to treatment plant performance. Prepares reports, letters and enforcement actions (including remedial engineering plans and programs) to achieve compliance with permits or regulations. Reviews and evaluates entities for new waste treatment and disposal facilities.

Reviews and processes permit to install (PTI) applications, general or facility plans, detailed engineering plans, National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits with appropriate effluent limitations, sludge management plans, infiltration -inflow analyses, SSES analyses, CSO reports for facilities and other documents required to be submitted to the Agency and recommends action to be taken (approval, disapproval or more information required to comply with state and Federal standards). Compares engineering designs and specifications with state and Federal standards and guidelines.

Prepares discharge permits for municipal, industrial and semi-public wastewater sources including appropriate limitations and monitoring requirements. Reviews present and proposed control strategies with preparations of compliance schedules where necessary. Reviews and responds to reports required by permits. Prepares reports, letters and enforcement actions relative to compliance with permits and regulations.

Provides engineering technical assistance to other agencies, industries, local governments and to the general public on environmental regulations. Advises engineers, architects and consulting engineering on interpretation of Federal and state environmental pollution requirements. Responds to citizen inquiries and complaints. Determines action necessary to eliminate the situation and prepares documentation for litigation. Participates in adjudication hearings as technical advisor on engineering methods to the Attorney General.

Conducts evaluation of municipal pretreatment program implementation (pretreatment compliance inspection/audits). Conducts follow-up, advises supervisor of measures that could be taken to achieve compliance with approval from local program and with state and Federal pretreatment requirements. Reviews recommendations to the Director through the supervisor for approval or denial of such requests.

Conducts inspections of industrial users to ensure correct categorization with respect to national pretreatment requirements, to evaluate spill control measures, to update file information on industrial processes, wastewater treatment and technology, and discharge characteristics.

Participates in professional engineering seminars and educational meetings for self-enrichment. Prepares reports dealing with environmental engineering and pollution control. Maintains technical knowledge through manuals, journals and literature. Performs other duties as required.
