RN to BSN BLENDED DELIVERY FAQ

What are the pre-requisite courses?

Prerequisite Coursework (no grade of less than C will be accepted):

- Anatomy & Physiology I & II
- College level Chemistry
- Microbiology
- Statistics
- Psychology
- English I & II

Is there an age limit for the science prerequisites?

No.

What is a Blended program?

A blended delivery program is a combination of in person and on line learning. Courses will be taught at a Cleveland Clinic facility for the in person delivery and CSU utilizes the Blackboard Learn for the on line content.

How long is the Blended program?

The RN to BSN BLENDED sequence is six consecutive semesters.

What is the cost?

\$215.00 per credit hour (plus a \$25 per credit hour technology fee)

What grade point average (GPA) is required for acceptance?

A minimum GPA of 2.00 is required for consideration to the program.

When would I start the Blended program if I were accepted?

RN to BSN blended students can choose to enter the program in spring or fall semester.

Does CSU still offer the on line RN to BSN program?

Yes. The on line program is still available. This program admits in the fall and spring semester.

When are applications available? When should I apply? When is the application deadline?

Complete applications are due July 1st for the Fall semester. Application for the Spring semester are due November 1st. Applications are available year round.

How many hours of work per week for classes?

This depends on the student – there is no way to give exact amounts of time.

What is the NUR 460 (clinical)?

This course is your final capstone. **This is a supervised, evidence based clinical project. Students work in conjunction with a Mentor.**

It is comprised of a total of 90 hours over 12 weeks if taken in the summer, over 16 weeks if taken in the fall.

There are volunteer hours required for Gerontology (NUR 409) and an on line group project assessing a local community for Community (NUR 441)

Are there requirements in addition to the Nursing courses?

Cleveland State University requires the completion of General Education requirements for all students earning a bachelor's degree. For more information refer to the following website:

Students who have previously earned a bachelor's degree are exempt from the general education requirements.

There is a CSU residency requirement for all students. This requires the last 30 hours of the degree be completed at CSU.
