## Responsibilities:

Through my time with Hopebridge I was responsible for two main purposes. The first was to provide one-on-one ABA therapy and secondly to maintain my Registered Behavior Technician (RBT) license.

One-on-One: I was responsible for establishing a controlled relationship with my client. I was to collect data electronically about client behavior/achievement through observation. I worked alongside Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBA) to teach the client's critical skills, such as communication.

Maintain License: I was required to have 5% of my RBT hours per month supervised by BCBA that also worked with my clients.





### **Lessons Learned:**

Through my internship I learned how to work alongside other professionals such as BCBA's, Occupational Therapist, and Speech Pathologist. I learned how to implement therapy plans to assist clients in reaching established critical skills.
