CSU Admissions Checklist

The following items are required to complete your application for College Credit Plus at Cleveland State University.

- *Special summer programs may require additional information. Please contact the coordinator or department.
- Completed and signed Application
- Official high school transcript
- Official ACT or SAT scores (Faxes are not acceptable.)

Application Deadlines

- APRIL 15 final deadline for summer semester
- JUNE 15 final deadline for fall semester
- NOVEMBER 1 final deadline for spring semester

For the best selection of classes apply by MAY 1.

Office of Undergraduate Admissions 2121 Euclid Avenue EC 100 Cleveland, Ohio 44115-2214 The College Credit Plus program at Cleveland State University is designed to provide qualified students with the opportunity to gain credit while supplementing their high school college preparatory curriculum.

Upon successful completion of the course, students will be awarded college credit through Cleveland State University and will receive a CSU transcript.

College Credit Plus Options

The College Credit Plus Program is intended to complement rather than replace the high school preparatory curriculum. Students who qualify for the program may enroll in college courses under the following options:

Option A: The student takes courses for college credit only and is responsible for payment of all tuition, books and fees.

Option B: The student takes courses for high school and college credit. Tuition, books and fees are paid through Ohio Department of Education funds.

Enrollment Options

Students admitted to the CCP Program are eligible to enroll for the fall, spring and summer terms. Students who elect to enroll during the summer term need to be aware that the during the summer term, courses are generally taught at an accelerated pace during six (6), eight (8), ten (10) and twelve (12) week sessions.

Admission Criteria

To ensure that a student succeeds in College Credit Plus at Cleveland State, applicants must meet the following admission requirements in order to participate:

- 2.3 high school cumulative GPA
- · ACT or SAT scores

ACT: Composite Score-16; English Score-20; Math Score-22

SAT: (March 2016 or later) Total score (EBRW and Math)-860; Reading Score-26; Math Score-550

CSU also offers an institutional ACT (iACT), which can ONLY be used for CSU admission: http://www.csuohio.edu/testingcenter/american-college-test-i-act

Please be sure to submit all of the application materials when you apply to the CCP Program. Applications will not be processed until all materials are received, including:

- · Completed application form
- High school transcripts
- ACT/SAT scores
- Advanced Placement test results (if applicable)

Admissions requirements are subject to change based on university policy or state legislation.

Orientation

Once admitted, ALL students are required to attend a College Credit Plus orientation session to introduce them to Cleveland State and to provide vital information about the program and the university. Information regarding this orientation will be forwarded following admission to the program.

Course Selection

The course selection process for students is a collaborative effort between the student, the high school counselor and the Cleveland State University advisor. Cleveland State is on a semester system that consists of fall and spring semesters, each lasting 15 weeks. You must register for new classes prior to the start of each term that you attend.

Maximum Course Loads

Students are eligible to earn a maximum of 30 credits per year. The number of credits a student is eligible for each semester is determined by the number of credits they are completing at their high school. Your high school counselor should be consulted about any additional restrictions.

Academic Standards

Students must maintain an overall 2.0 GPA or better to remain in the program. Students earning less than a 2.0 cumulative GPA will be dismissed from CSU's CCP program.

Admission to Cleveland State College Credit Plus does not guarantee acceptance as a degree-seeking student. The student must reapply and meet University requirements to be admitted as an undergraduate.
