

2017-2018 Federal Dependent Verification Worksheet

Your 2017-2018 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) has been selected for review in a process called “Verification”. In this process, CSU will compare the information you provided on your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet along with other required documents. If there are any discrepancies, corrections will be made and your financial aid eligibility may be adjusted.
