FACILITY	# OF SPACES	TYPE OF SPACES	LOCATION
M1	9	Permit Only	Access from East 18th Street between Chester Avenue and Euclid Avenue, located in the small alley on the west side of the road.
M2	13	Permit and Meter	Access from East 19th Street off of Chester Avenue, take the road past the Central Garage entrance around the curve. The motorcycle spaces are in the alley on the south side of the Central Garage.
M3	9	Permit and Meter	Located inside Lot 22 (Student Center Lot) at the south end of the lot. Lot 22 is located off of East 22nd Street between Euclid Avenue and Chester Avenue.
M4	4	Permit Only	Located inside of Lot 65 (Rec Center Lot) off of Chester Avenue.
M5	2	Permit Only	Located near the entrance to East Garage.
M6	12	Permit Only	Lot 54, enter from East 24th between Chester Avenue and Payne Avenue.

MOTORCYCLE PARKING PROGRAM

Any motorized vehicle that has two wheels will be defined as a motorcycle and this includes mopeds and vehicles with smaller engines.

PARKING LOCATIONS*

There are a total of 50 motorcycle spaces (specially marked ½ spaces) on campus. Any vehicle found outside of a permitted motorcycle parking location will receive a violation. Motorcycles may not park in automated garages, CSU buildings, standard vehicle spaces, bike racks, or on sidewalks. The University assumes no responsibility for the care and protection of motorcycles while on campus.

PARKING RATES & PERMITS**

- Motorcycles can be added to an active CSU Green or White Parking Permit at no additional charge. An active CSU Green or White Permit will extend to the motorcycle, at locations with motorcycle spaces only.
- A separate motorcycle permit can be purchased by CSU staff and students in the Parking Office only (E. 24th & Euclid). Motorcycle permits are not valid for overnight parking and are not eligible for returns or refunds.
- Payment can be made with cash or credit card. Payment via payroll deduction and student account cannot be used.
- Motorcycle license plate, make, model, color and year are required when registering.
- Permits can only be used by the registered permit holder, are non-transferrable, and allow for only one registered vehicle/motorcycle to park at any given time.
- Motorcycles are subject to the same citation discount policies and escalation fee schedule as vehicles.
