Confucius Institute Scholarship For Studying Abroad in China

Introduction

The Confucius Institute Scholarship program will sponsor foreign students, scholars, and Chinese language teachers studying Chinese Language and Culture, Chinese History, Chinese Philosophy, or other such majors at designated universities in China.

Scholarship Category:

- Scholarship for Four-Week Students
- Scholarship for One-Semester Students
- Scholarship for One-Academic Year Students

• Scholarship for Students Seeking a Master's Degree in Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages

Scholarship Coverage:

Scholarship winners are exempt from tuition, accommodation fees on campus, are provided comprehensive insurance for foreign students studying in China, and receive a monthly living allowance (except Four-Week Scholarship Students).

Eligibility Criteria:

• Applicants shall be non-Chinese citizens in good health, aged between 16 and 35 (Chinese language teachers in post shall be aged below 45).

• Applicants need to take HSK and HSKK or BCT exam and achieve a score which meet the basic standard of the category you would like to apply for.

Time Schedule:

- Oct. Dec., 2015 Applicants register by email and take the HSK and HSKK or BCT exam.
- Jan. Mar., 2016 Applicants prepare their application documents and are interviewed by the Confucius Institute at Cleveland State University.
- Mar. Apr., 2016 Applicants complete and submit the application forms online.
- *May Jun., 2016* Applicants are selected by the host institute; The Confucius Institute headquarters reviews the applications and makes a final selection.
- Jul. Sep., 2016 Winners make final preparations and then depart for China.
