



### Resume

- Put the things that matter first!

#### Be targeted in your approach

Offer the specific qualifications you possess to perform the job advertised. Use a customized resume for each position. If you choose to use a general resume, than customize your cover letter to the position.

#### **University of Michigan:**

- Academic Statement of Purpose The Statement of Purpose should be a concise, well-written statement about your academic and research background, your career goals, and how Michigan's graduate program will help you meet your career and educational objectives.
- **Personal Statement** The Personal Statement should contain your background and life experiences, including cultural, geographical, financial, educational or other opportunities or challenges, which motivated your decision to pursue a graduate degree at the University of Michigan. For example, if you grew up in a community where educational, cultural, or other opportunities were either especially plentiful or especially lacking, or are undocumented or DACAmented, you might discuss the impact this had on your development and interests. This should be a discussion of the journey that has led to your decision to seek a graduate degree.



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#### **Ohio State:**

- Your statement of purpose should be no more than two pages in length, double-spaced, in Times New Roman, Arial, or Calibri size 10 or 12 font and it should address the following topics:
- Give examples of experiences or demonstrated attributes that have prepared you to be successful in graduate school.
- Identify the reason you want to pursue a graduate degree. Identify career goals and how you see a graduate degree enabling your career goals.
- Describe a personal or academic challenge that you have faced and how you successfully handled this challenge.
- Incorporate some information about your extracurricular activities into your statement of purpose where it makes sense to do so. Those activities and how they have shaped you are crucial if you wish to be competitive for fellowship consideration.
- Do not include "fluff" or filler content. Focus on why you are qualified and what you want to do in graduate school.
- Proofread your statement of purpose before you submit it and make sure it's relevant to your application to Ohio State and clearly written/free of errors. Expressing interest in faculty members or research that are not available at Ohio State or our department can negatively impact an applicants chances of admission greatly.



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- Be sure to read the specific requirements for the school.
- Address any weaknesses in your application here and explain why they are not a negative for your application.

• Proofread!!

• Use your Network: Have a mentor read your statement.





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
