If the A&S foreign language requirement was fulfilled in High School, the eight (8) university credits listed here must still be taken in any subject in order to reach the 120 total credit hours required for the degree.

Current DH courses in History include HIS 364: Caribbean History to 1804; HIS 367: Modern Latin America; HIS 378: History of Kenya; HIS 455: Gender in European History; HIS 471: Politics of Protest and Gender.
