

A Note About Classes with Zero Students

We are NOT requiring a syllabus for every section in Campusnet. When we generate reports from Simple Syllabus, we will **ignore sections with 0 students** in them.

We cannot "remove" or "fail to send over" the sections with 0 students because we then run the risk that a section will not be in the system even though a faculty knows students will eventually be in it.

Many departments create independent study, internship sections, or music lesson classes for all the potential faculty advisors so that if students need to register at the last minute, they can do so. This is a good practice that we do not want to inhibit.

The sections with 0 students will be in a faculty member's "To Do" list. Faculty can ignore those syllabi, but the **important thing to note** is that if a student registers for that independent study, internship, etc., then we **DO NEED A SYLLABUS**. Those syllabi do not take long to make, but they do need to be completed.
