

3344-13-02 (N) Faculty Senate Attendance

A faculty senator who cannot attend a senate meeting shall provide notice to the Faculty Senate Secretary no fewer than twenty-four hours in advance of the meeting. Failure to provide such notice will constitute an unexcused absence for the Senator, to be recorded by the Faculty Senate Secretary. If a senator accumulates two unexcused absences during an academic year, the Faculty Senate Secretary will inform the caucus of the college represented by the senator of the absenteeism. If a senator has been declared an absentee, the college caucus will have the option to replace the absentee senator using the temporary election provisions described in provision 3344-13-02 (B)(4) of this policy.
